

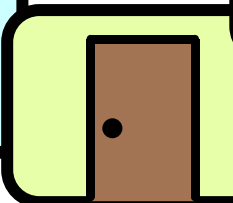
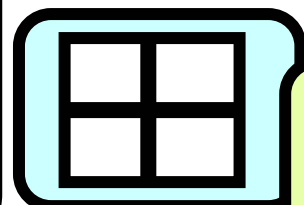
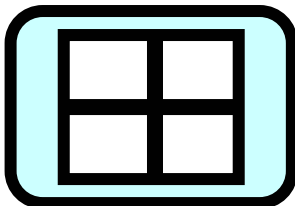
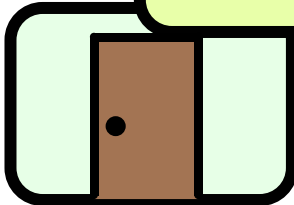
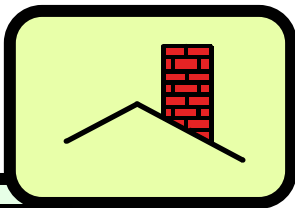
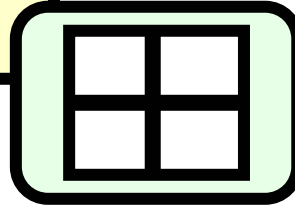
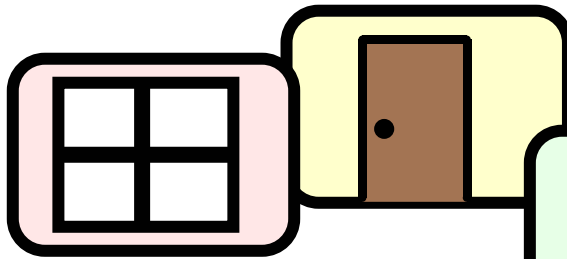
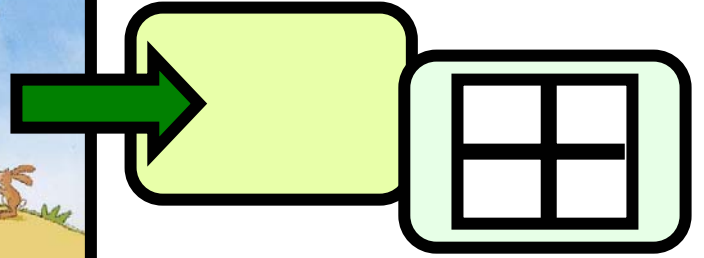
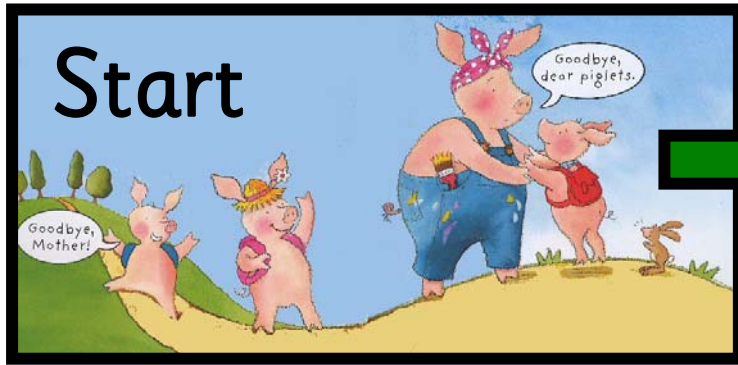
The Three Pigs Build a House Game

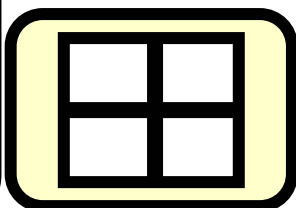
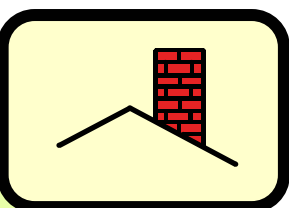
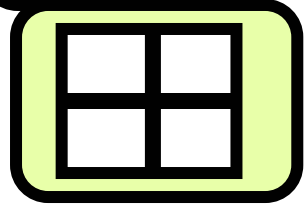
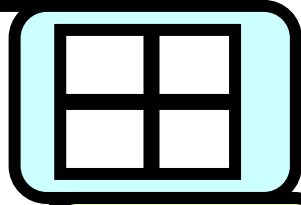
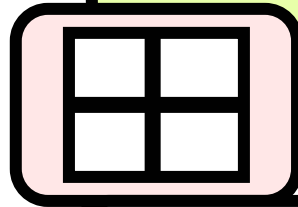
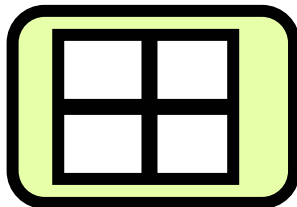
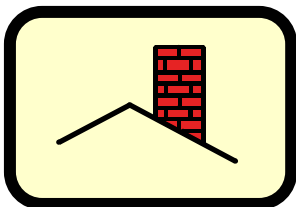
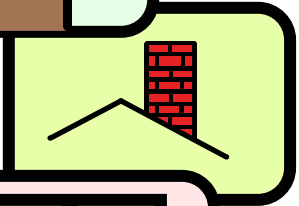
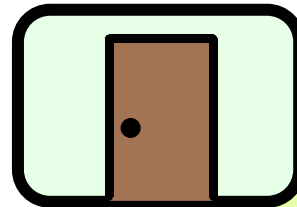
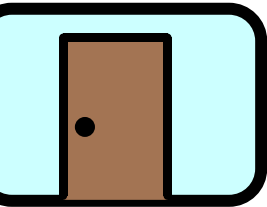
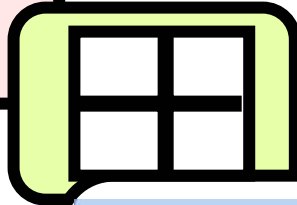
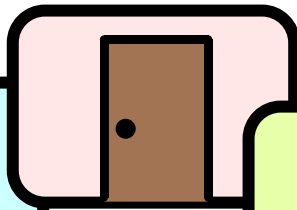
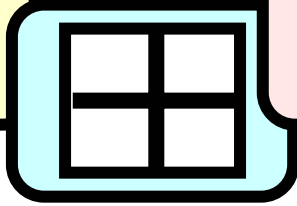
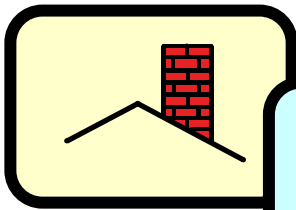
You will need: 1 game boards (A3), 4 house boards (A4), House element cards, 4 coloured counters, dice or spinner.

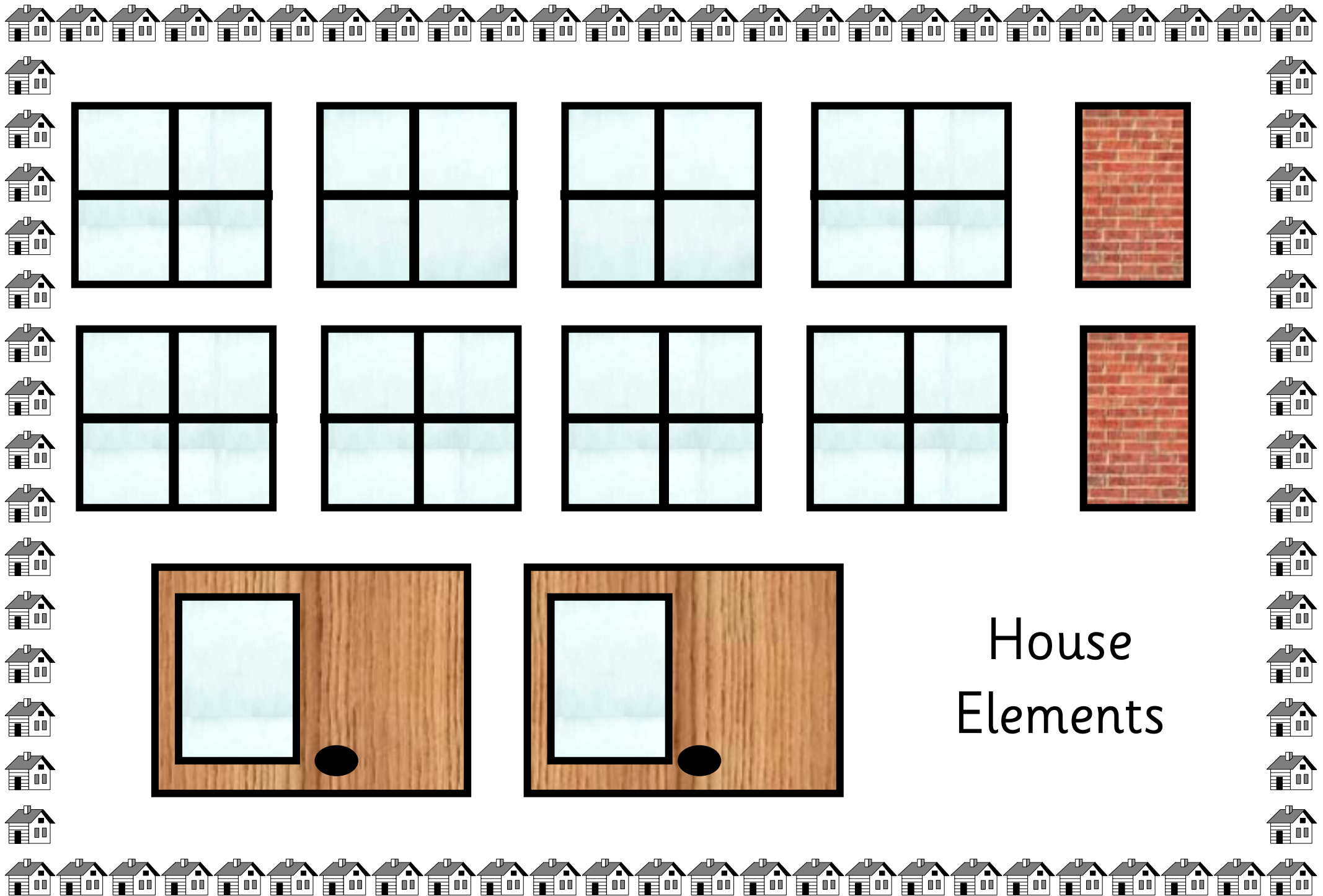
