Resources to include

Communication, Language and Literacy

Use spoken and written language in their play

Links sounds to letters, naming and sounding letters of the alphabet

Use their phonic knowledge to read and write simple regular words and make phonetically plausible attempts at more complex words
Explore and experiment with sounds, words and texts

Read a range of familiar and common words and simple sentences independently

Attempt writing for different purposes

Write own name and other things such as labels and captions and begin to form simple sentences

Use a pencil and hold it effectively to form recognisable letters
