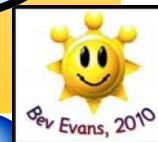

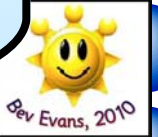


I can scan to identify key

help me understand.



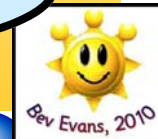
I can use the author's

I can identify the different features of fiction genres.

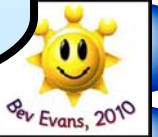


I can compare, contrast and evaluate different non-fiction texts.
