Instructions

Give each child a copy of the same board. Each child in turn uses the 'tens' spinner and the 'units' spinner and adds their numbers together to make a two digit number. The then write this number on their board but they must choose carefully. They must write it in a space where it is a multiple of the number at the top of the column or the side of the row: players can score a point for each 'correctly' placed number. Take turns and fill your board: the winner is the person with the biggest total.

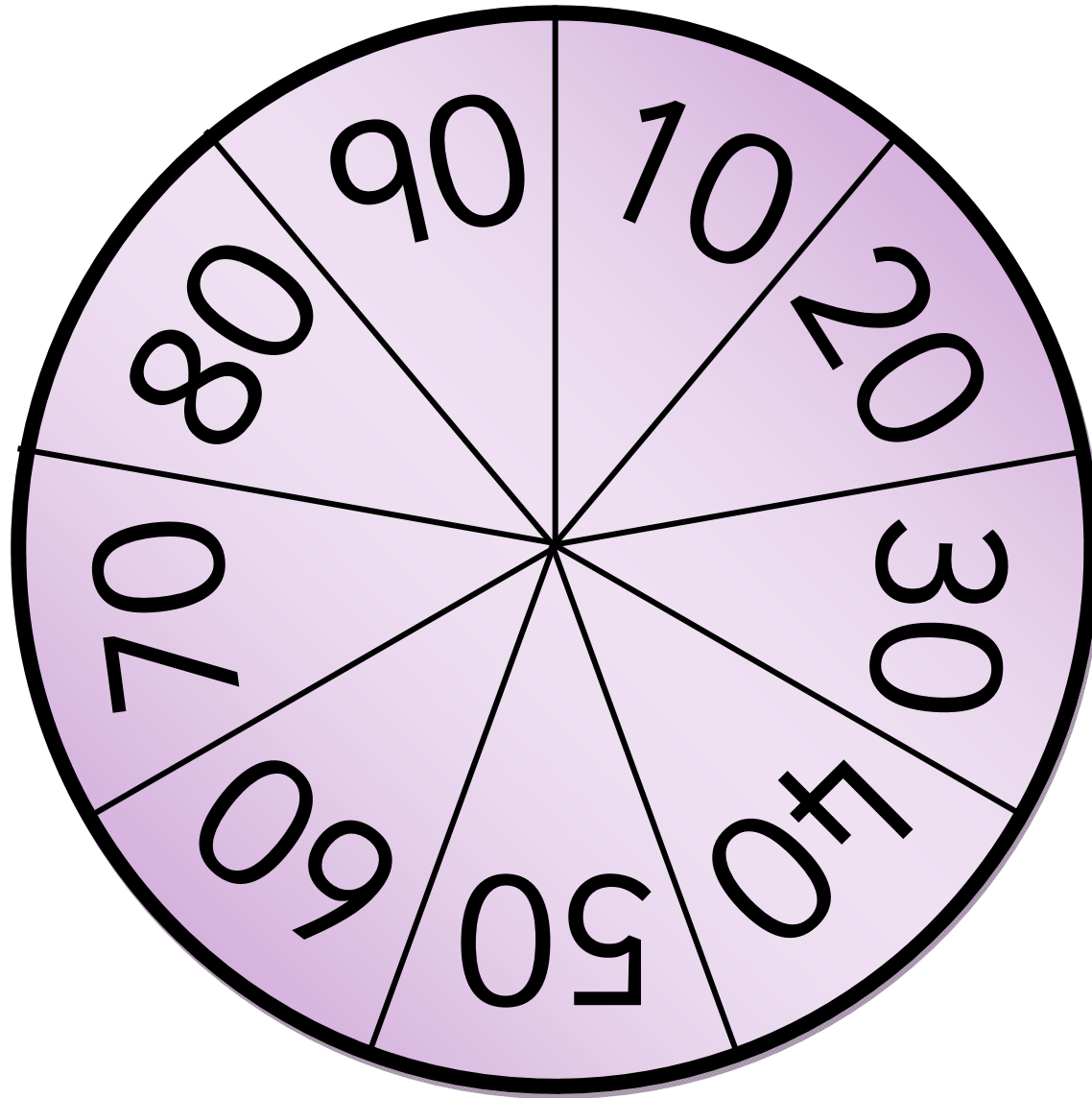
