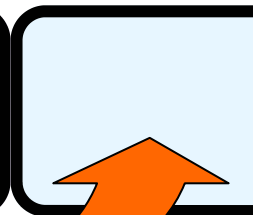
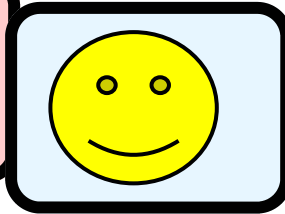
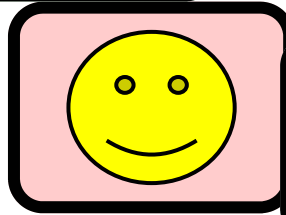
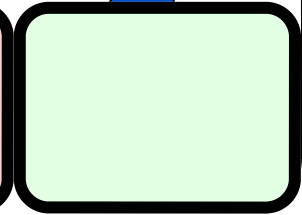
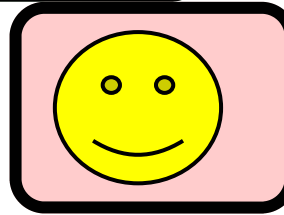
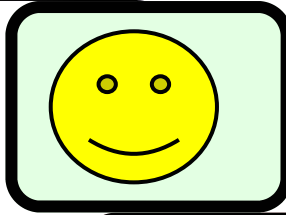
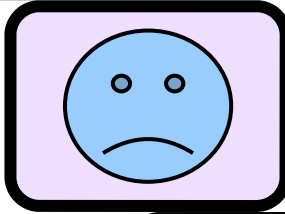
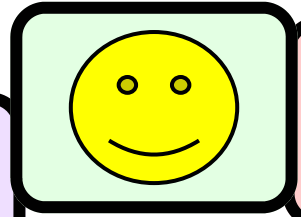
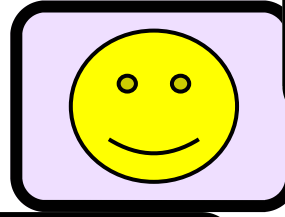
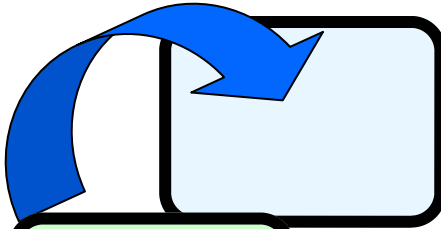
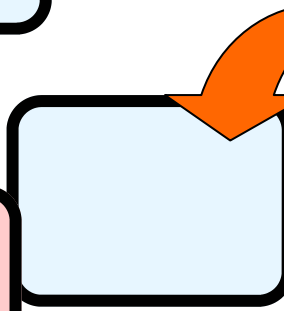
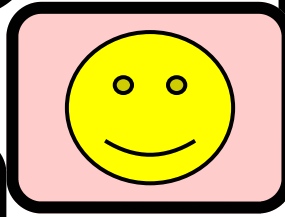
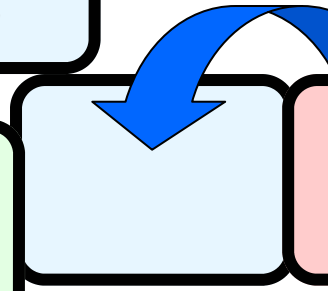
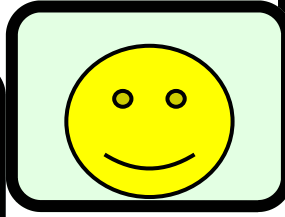
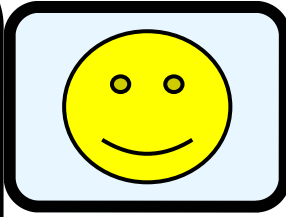
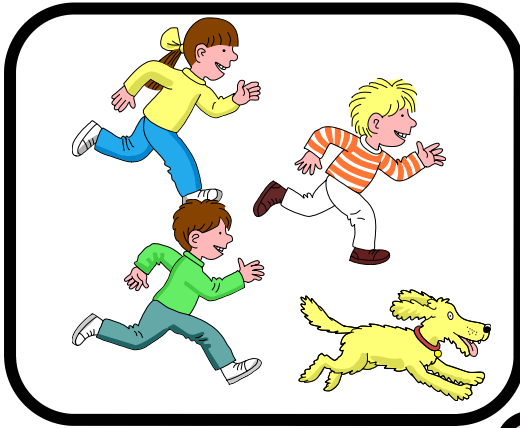


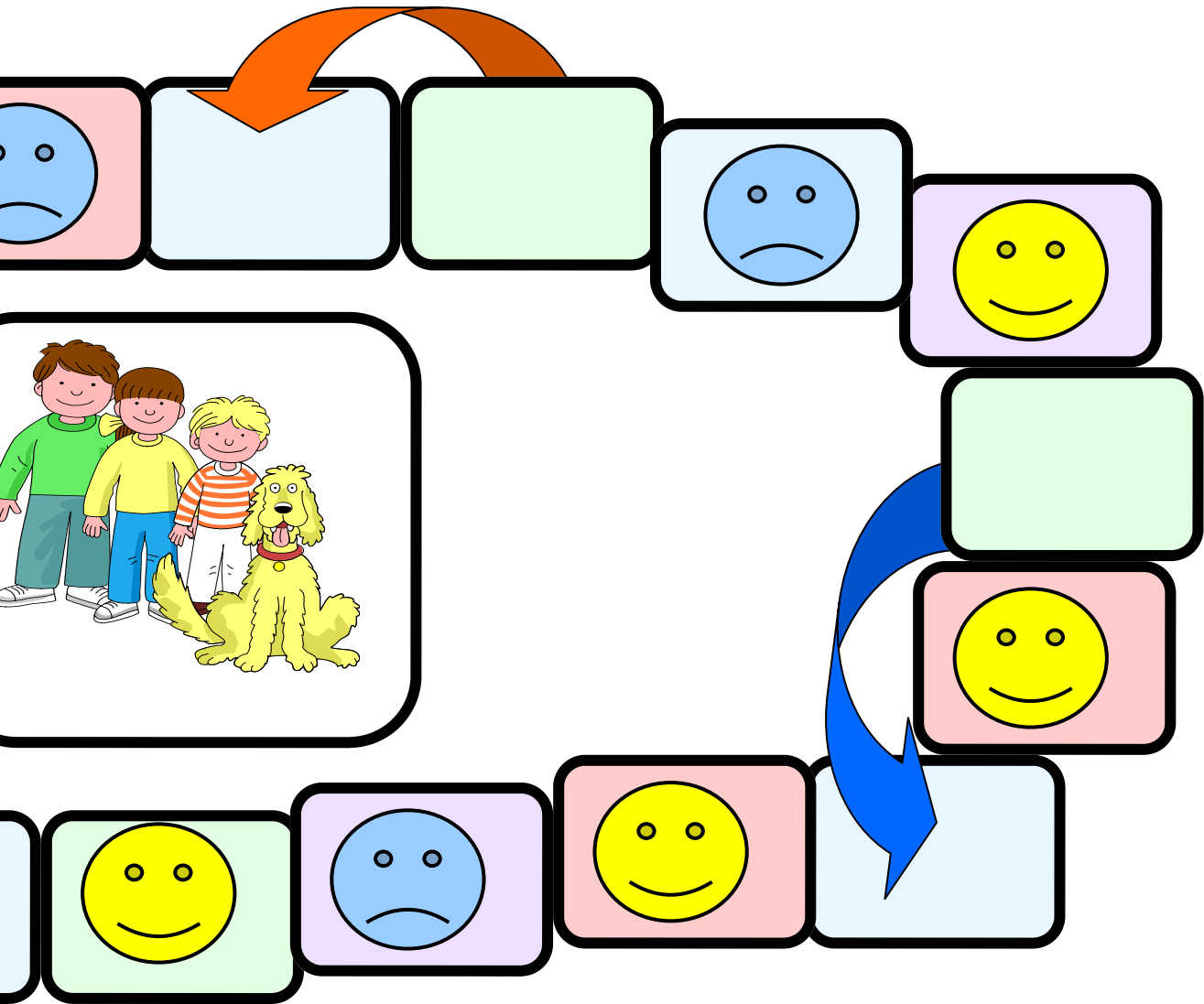
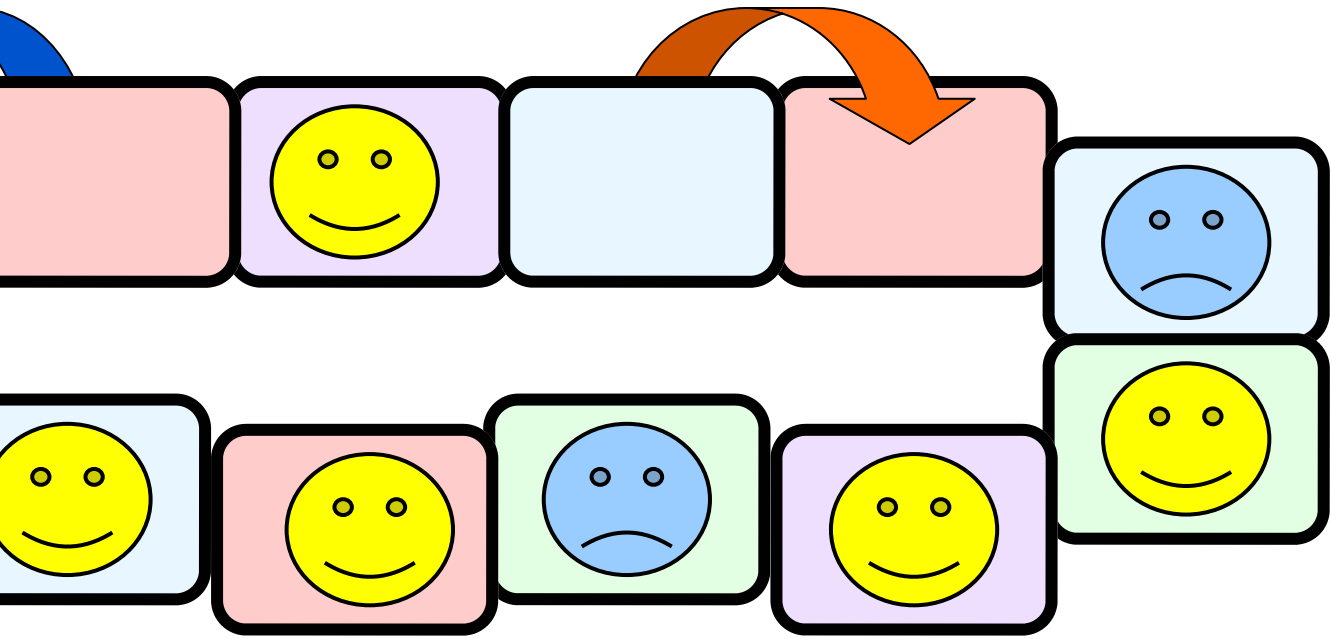
You will need: 1 Game Board (A3), a set of ORT word cards, a dice or spinner and 4 coloured counters.

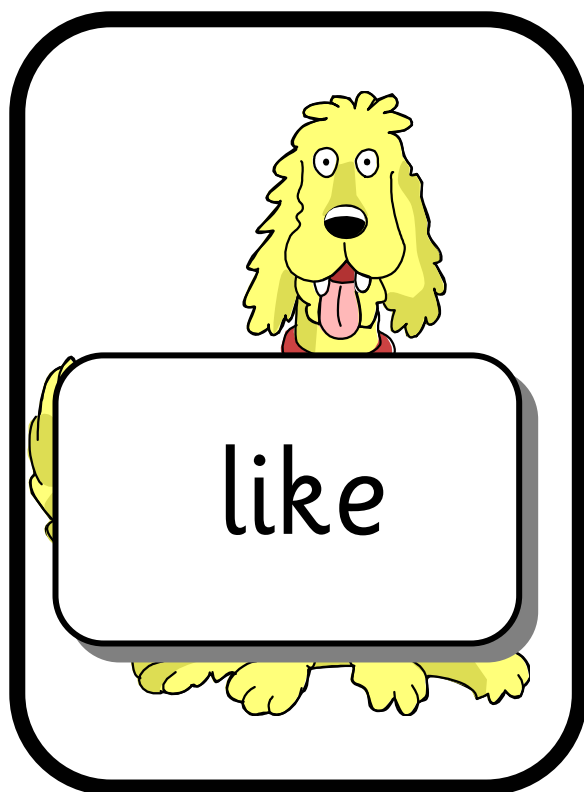
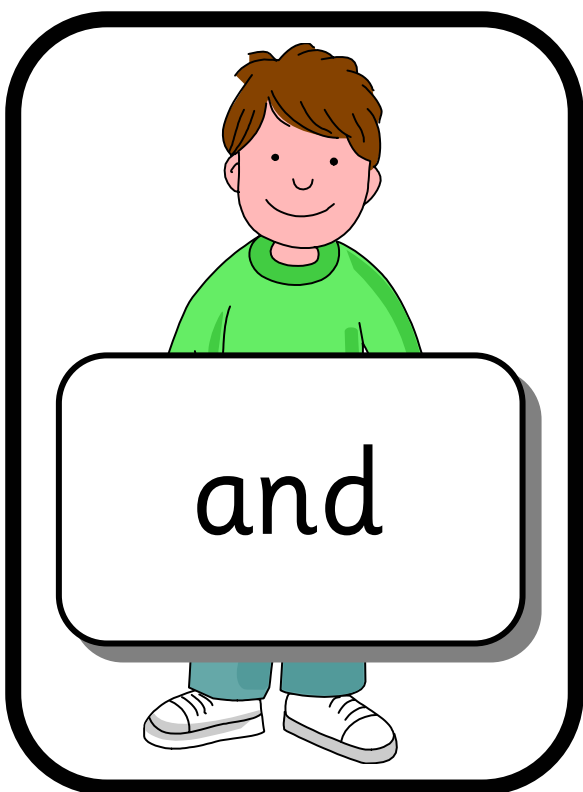
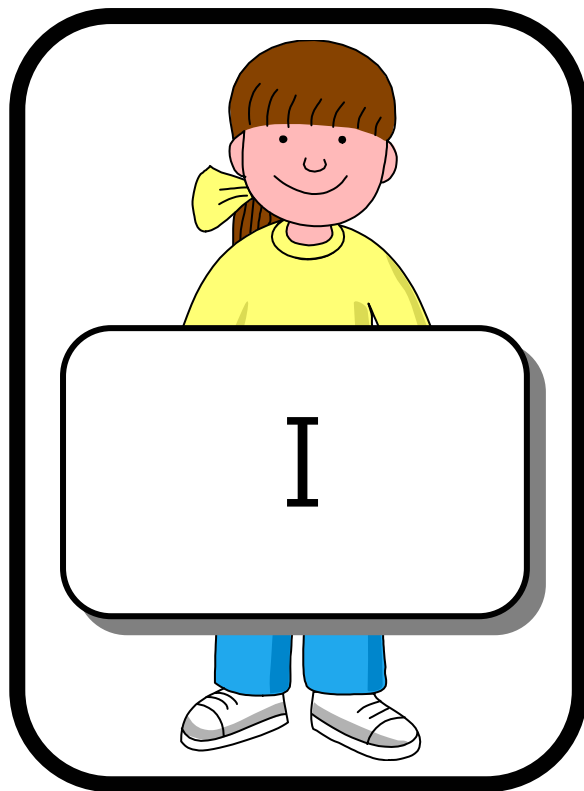
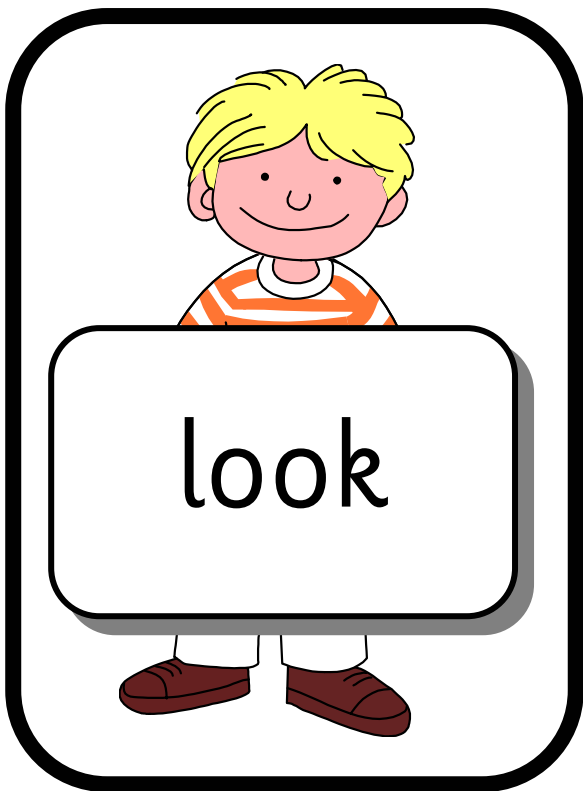
