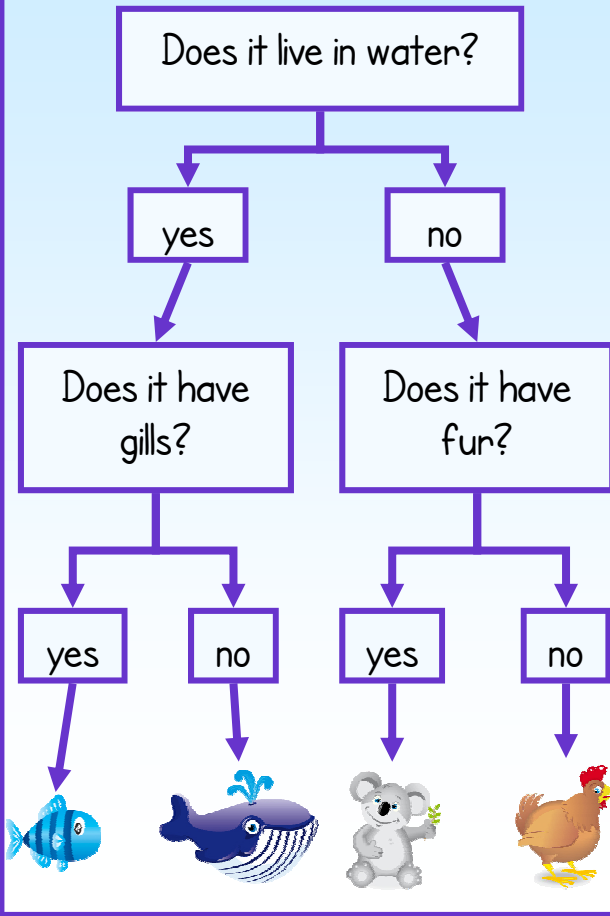
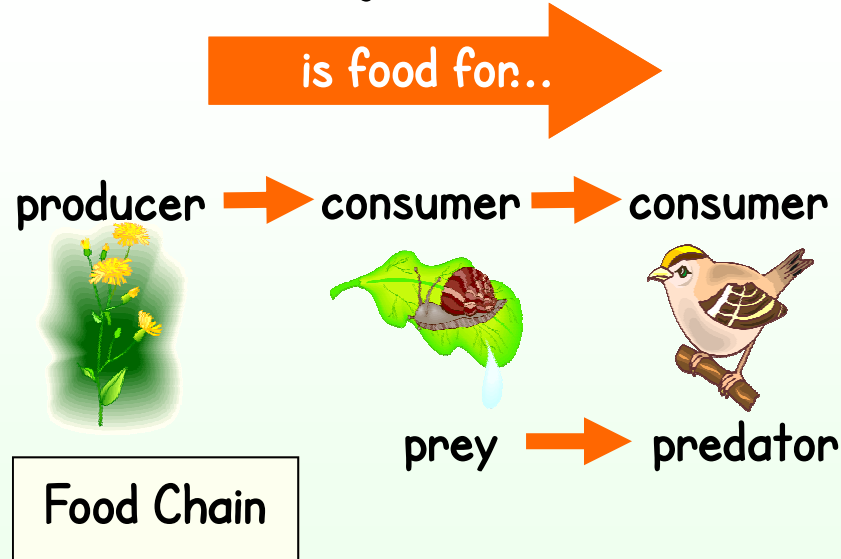

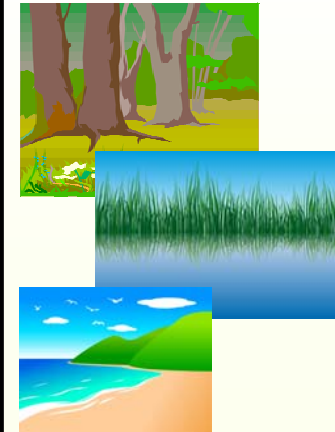
A **key** like this can be used to **sort, classify** and **identify** things.



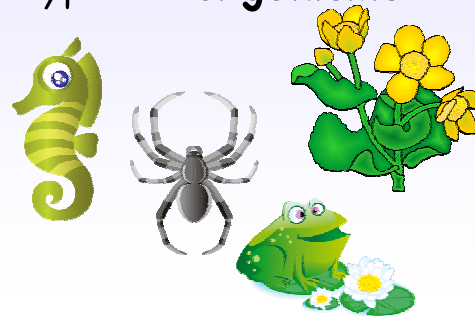
On a food chain diagram the arrow means...



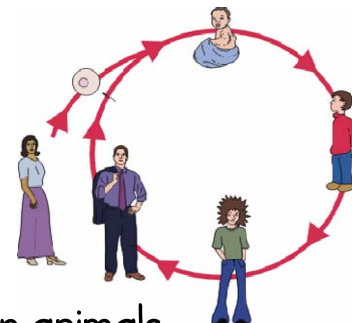
These are different habitats

Habitats Glossary

consumer - all animals are consumers - they eat either producers or other consumers	nutrition - means food or feeding either by plants or animals
food chain - the link between a producer and the consumers - e.g. the rose produces food for the greenfly which then becomes food for the ladybird	organism - any living creature, plant or animal
	predator - an animal that eats other animals
habitat - the place where animals and plants live e.g. seashore, woodland etc.	prey - an animal that is eaten by another animal
key - a chart that places things in a logical way in order to sort and classify them	producer - any green plant that makes its own food and so produces food for the food chain
life cycle - the important stages in the life of an organism	reproduce - to make new, young organisms
